**Groundbreaking for The Institute for the Hispanic Family**

Catholic Charities is pleased to announce that the official groundbreaking for the new home of The Institute for the Hispanic Family will take place tomorrow, June 8, 2007, at 1:30 PM at 73 Cedar Street in Hartford, CT. When finished, the 22,000 square foot building will serve as the premier family center for the Greater Hartford Latino Community. The new facility will house a child guidance clinic, a day care program, family support services, substance abuse programs, and health and wellness services for the senior Hispanic population of Hartford, consolidating these programs in one location for better client service.

The project is being funded by the Archdiocese of Hartford, the City of Hartford, the Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities Authority, the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving and the State of Connecticut Department of Social Services. Occupancy is expected in the Spring of 2008.
